


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


Various complexes of themes for the proposals for the preservation


1. Strategy for the area in the south: green area, sites for a buildings
2. Strategy for the area in the north: staff units, traffic, green area, site for a building
3. Scheme creating a central service unit for the main entrance and -organisation:
 - Visitor centre, shops, service, education, restaurants and so on
 - Capacity: up to 1.000 visitors per day ~ 3.000 m², nearly: 3x 25 x 40m
4. Traffic demand management:
 - entry for pedestrian, by car, by coach,
 - parking cars and busses, public transport, staff parking
5. Museum complexes
 - War museum ?
 - Ancient citadel
6. Functional arrangements:
 - ways for customers and staff in the site,
 - connection with the archaeological site,
 - accessibility for handicapped people

General Objectives

1. Protection, Preservation and enhancement of the historical cultural values in the site as monuments of national culture and history - Steps to keep the context and the continuity among natural, landscape and urban elements in a territory,
2. Development and enhancement of urban and architectural quality
3. Improvement and development the relics and buildings for national and international tourist activities
4. Development of local business, commerce and tourism
5. Sustainable development with reduce of consumption of non-renewable resources, minimize waste, protect the nature and create healthy environments



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
Requirement

 2. Structural and historic analyzing in steps
 3. Defining different preservation and implementation areas with several priorities after evaluation

 4. Creating pilot projects

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

 The ramparts of Đại La: rebuilt in 1749, entered through 8 then 16 gates (1831), including 11 to the east facing the Red River




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


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
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



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Example for the depiction



